



Those of you who have watched our program over the years realize we have focused on two major thrusts in our breeding program.

- 1) We try to make about half of our fall born bulls as big and stout as we can, and we don't worry a lot about birth weights. For a certain segment of our market that wants Angus bulls that can go toe-to-toe with the exotics, these are the bulls they look for. We use sires like DIVERSITY, 5175, HI ROAD, SAF CHOICE PLUS 8275, and SAF CASH 7203 to create these sires, along with outside sires that will add frame and power.
- 2) Our major thrust has been to create bulls that are safe to use on heifers with as much growth as possible, along with special emphasis on marbling

for carcass quality, and scrotal circumference for added fertility. Since the majority of our customers market their calves closer to weaning age than yearling age, and because we think a higher WW EPD compared to YW EPD should work to hold down mature cow size, we've used WW EPD as our main selection criteria for growth.

So how are we doing?

you sort the main sire summary of some 3,000 sires, with maximum BW and minimum Scrotal EPDs in the top half of the breed, along with an IMF EPD of .20 (top 10%), and rank them by WW EPD, the #1 sire is SAF STRATEGY 9015, #2 is LEACHMAN BOOM TIME, #3 is SAF CHOICE PLUS

8275, #7 is SAF FOCUS J30, #8 is SAF FOCUS of ER, #19 is SAF CHOICE PLUS, and #20 is SAF FOCUS 903.

Sorting the Young Sire Summary with the same parameters, the #1 WW sire is SAF DIRECTIVE. Now, these same sires may or may not be the ones that fit best into your program, but they do illustrate the progress that can be made by selecting and b reeding cattle to do a specific job.
