This outstanding two-year-old donor by E161 is out of a powerful Hi Road daughter with one of the best progeny records you will find. 6028 has 5 BR-96, 5 WR-109, and 5 YR-107; 36 progeny scanned with average IMF ratio of 106, REA ratio of 102 and Ribfat ratio of 87. Few cows can combine that kind of carcass quality with such low fat cover. SAF Blackbird 6028 was the top-selling spring calver in our 2003 sale at \$15,000 to Greiner & Henry Angus, Indianola, IA. A flush sister to SydGen Blackbird 3195 was one of the top fall yearlings in our 2004 sale at \$4,000 to Seagraves Angus, Mulberry Grove, IL. Maternal brothers out of 6028 include SydGen On The Mark, co-owned with Vision Angus, and SydGen Rocky Road 2060, the +50.14 \$B bull owned with Mike Kasten.

In the tradition of her dam, SydGen Blackbird 3195 ratioed 111 for IMF, 111 for UREA and 80 for Ribfat.
