With his first calf crop totally processed, CC&7 debuted on the Main Sire Summary as the Number 1 Sire for Docility EPD and the Number 12 Sire on the \$B index. Consistent with his individual REA scan of 17.3 sq. in. and his top-ranking 365-day adj. YW of 1,467 lbs., CC&7 ranks in the top 1% of current sires for REA, WW, YW, \$F and \$B.

Breeders across the country are impressed with their CC&7 progeny. His 19 yearling sons at the Hoover Angus sale in February averaged \$7,187, topped by the \$47,500 Hoover Dam. His dam is proving to be a prepotent source of muscling genetics, with 9 progeny scanned at 110 REA ratio yet still posting 102 ratio for IMF. Semen \$25

Mandate's first calf crop has earned him an incredible EPD profile, near the top of the breed in every trait. He has debuted on the Main Sire Summary as the Number 7 \$B Sire, and his sire is the only bull on the Sire Summary to exceed his combined \$W and \$B Value of +\$110.46. He is also the only negative BW EPD proven sire to rank in the top 1% for both \$W and \$B. He also ranks in the top 1% of proven sires for CED, WW EPD, YW EPD and \$F. The Mandate calves seem excellent on Docility, and his sons exhibit superior scrotal development. Mandate sired the top-selling bull in the 2009 TK Angus Bull Sale, and his progeny scanned are averaging 112 ratio for %IMF. Semen \$25.

Owned with Three Trees Ranch, Sharpsburg, GA, and 7L Farms, Wiggins, MS Forward entered the spotlight as the top-selling bull of the breed's 2006 calf crop when he topped the 2007 Connealy sale at \$160,000 after posting an adj. YW of 1,495 lbs. and scanning a 17.1 REA. His proof has substantiated his performance, and he now ranks in the top 3% of current sires for YW EPD and the top 2% for REA EPD, while maintaining a CED EPD in the top 15% for current proven sires. Forward has surfaced as a breed source for muscling and performance, yet with moderate BW and positive SC. His calves are consistently long and thick-made, and have been well-received wherever they have been offered. Semen \$30.
