CC&7 is the first natural calf out of 4087. As the Number 10 sire for registrations in fiscal 2011, and Number 4 in fiscal 2012, CC&7 has earned a high-accuracy EPD profile that is useful, salable and profitable. Hoover Angus have sold 158 sons for \$1,031,730 since 2009 to average \$6529. CC&7 recently debuted as a Pathfinder® Sire with a very high percentage of his eligible daughters qualifying, demonstrating the breed-back of his milking daughters may be as strong as his HP EPD that ranks in the top 5% of proven sires. Docility and Milk in the top 1%, \$B in the top 2% and REA in the top 3% of proven sires. Number 2 RADG sire in the breed at his accuracy level.

This sire-line descendant of GT Expo and Scotch Cap preserves one of the breed's most proven sources of carcass merit. In fact, he traces four times to Scotch Cap, the most heavily used son of one of the breed's few RTF designated sires, PS Power Play. GOOGOL was the \$25,000 top-selling bull in the 2011 SydGen Production Sale, going to Springvale Ranch, where he was a popular attraction of the Montana Angus Tour for his smoothness and athleticism, docility, depth of heel and foot structure. GOOGOL's first daughter to sell brought \$7,000 as a 5 ½ month old heifer calf at the 2013 Missouri Angus Futurity. His first calves at Springvale Ranch are just now being born.

As the only calf resulting from the mating of "Whiskey" to the powerful 4087 cow, **JACK DANIEL** brings a powerful pedigree, exceptional performance, and a strong genomic profile to the table. The few "Whiskey" sons available are surfacing to the top of many programs, and this is the only one out of 4087. With an actual BW of 86 lbs. and an adj. WW of 759 lbs., JACK DANIEL was developed through the heat of last summer on a limited ration with plenty of exercise. At 366 days of age, he weighed 1,328 lbs. and had a 42 cm SC measurement. He will see extensive use in the SydGen and Indian Springs programs this year and is currently standing at ORIgen.
