

Many of the Angus breed's greatest success stories had their beginnings on the Saturday before Thanksgiving in Mexico, MO

- 1993 Sale-SAF FAME topped the sale at \$27,000 to Van Nice Angus Ranch, but went on to generate over \$1.8 million in semen sales to date.
- 1995 Sale-SAF 598 BANDO 5175 sold for \$2,800 to Elm View Angus, Bath, SD. He later re-sold in their 1998 dispersion for \$6,000 to Schaff's Angus Valley, and generated more than \$1 million in semen sales at Genex.
- 1995 Sale-SAF Royal Lass 5184 sold as an 8-month-old heifer calf for \$4,000 to Fretwell Angus, Monticello, MO. She later topped his 2000 Consolidation Dispersion at \$26,500 to NER Farms.
- 1996 Sale-SAF FOCUS OF ER shattered all our sale records at \$68,000 to Edwards Angus Ranch, Denton, MT, but has gone on to generate more than \$1.5 million in semen sales to date.
- 1996 Sale-TK Karen 1369 sold for \$4,000 to A&M Circle T Farms. The calf she was carrying, Famous 7001, later became the 2000 National Western Stock Show Grand Champion Bull, generated exceptional semen sales revenue, and became the unprecedented sire of both the Grand and Reserve Grand Champion Bulls at the 2003 National Western Stock Show.
- 1996 Sale-SAF Royal Lass 5158 sold as a \$6,000 bred heifer to Grandview Plantation, Como, MS. She later topped the 2001 Grandview/Womack Sale at \$48,000 to Kahn Cattle Co., Rydal, GA, and sold in the Kahn Dispersion for \$100,000 to Southern Cattle Co., Marianna, FL.
- 1997 Sale-SAF Royal Lass 7036 sold for \$4,750 to Bob & Cathy Watkins' Beaver Ridge Farm, Middletown, IN. Utilizing his breeding privilege, Bob inseminated the heifer to SAF NEUTRON. The resulting calf, named BR Royal Lass 7036-19, produced, as her first calf, the \$202,000 Midland Bull Test sale topper and now the No. 1 proven IMF sire of the Angus breed, BR Midland. SAF Royal Lass 7036 has since been sold into the donor program of Anne Patton Schubert. The daughter of "7036," BR Royal Lass 70636-19, was the \$165,000 top-selling cow of the 2004 Baldridge Brothers Sale.
- 2000 Sale-SAF Estelle 4130 sold for \$1,900 with a baby bull calf at side to Graupman Angus, Palmyra, MO. After ratioing 250 for IMF in his contemporary group there, he was re-acquired and went on to sell for \$22,000 in our 2002 Sale to Express Genetics, Yukon, OK. SYDGEN STERLING 0298 currently records the second highest IMF EPD of all proven sires on the young sire summary.
- 2000 Sale-SAF CONNECTION topped the sale at \$50,000 to Van Nice Angus Ranch, then became one of the first sires enrolled in the ORigen program and picked up by ABS. He is now gaining considerable momentum in the semen sales arena.
- 2001 Sale-SAF DIRECTIVE sold for \$25,000 to Big Dry Angus Ranch, and was our leading semen sales bull in 2003.
