4087 is powerful in her phenotype and her performance.

She produced SydGen CC&7 as her first natural calf. CC&7 dominated the 2006 SydGen bull calf crop and topped our 2006 sale at \$39,000 for half interest and full possession to Hoover Angus Farm, Tingley, IA.

4087 currently ranks in the top 1% of current dams for WW, YW and \$B; the top 2% for Scrotal, \$W, \$F and \$G; the top 4% for Milk and Marbling; and the top 10% for REA and Fat EPDs. Six daughters are retained, with several ET pregnancies due this fall. Due September 30, 2010, to Basin King U127. More details will be available later.



Perhaps the breed's most popular and widely-used sire in 2010, CC&7 records the No. 1 Docility EPD in the Angus breed and ranks in the top 1% of proven sires for YW, REA and \$B.



This son of SydGen Forever Lady 4087 sired by SydGen Turbo was the \$11,500 third high-selling bull calf in our record-setting 2009 sale, behind two direct sons of CC&7. Co-owned with Ken Haas, LaGrange, WY.
