33rd Annual Production Sale November 19, 2011

As always, our annual sale is a virtual dispersion of our seven-year-old females, and this year will include many of our top donors.

The dam of the popular ORigen/ABS sire SydGen Mandate 6079, 4235 records 3 BR-102, 3 WR-107, 3 YR-109, 3 IMF-98 and 3 REA-102.

A daughter of the ORigen sire SAF Focus J30, she has produced 28 transferable embryos in three flushes to date, and will sell open and ready to flush. A son was a Reserve Division Champion at the 2011 Missouri Angus Futurity, selling to Graupman Angus in MO for \$5,000. Her only daughter to sell was selected by Express Ranches in Oklahoma, and we have exported embryos to Sterita Park in Australia. Gina sells with a February heifer calf at side by SydGen Liberty GA 8627, and ET progeny by SydGen 928 Destination 5420.

This daughter of B/R New Dimension 7127 offers a beautiful phenotype along with powerful carcass EPDs. A daughter of the cow who is a past Number 1 dam for IMF EPD, she has produced 39 transferable embryos in 4 flushes, and records 4 BR-111, 4 WR-104, 3 YR-100, 8 IMF-102, and 8 REA-103.

5273 is the dam of SydGen TL Bullet 8511, a 2009 Missouri Angus Futurity Reserve Division Champion and third high-seller, who has earned a solid set of EPDs for Triple L Ranch and Spring Cove Ranch in Idaho. Another son sold through Midland 2009 to Rees Brothers in Utah, and she has an outstanding set of fall calves selling by SydGen Contact. Primrose is due in late September to SydGen Liberty GA 8627.

This daughter of B/R New Design 323 offers incredible genetics for muscle, in an extremely easy-keeping, thick-made package. With a REA EPD ranking well into the top 1% of current dams, she has produced 14 transferable embryos in two flushes. Her progeny record is 5 BR-101, 5 WR-103, 4 YR-103, 8 IMF-104, and 8 REA-103.

Her dam was the \$14,000 selection of Camp Cooley Ranch in Texas in our 2003 offering; her daughter, SydGen Mademoiselle 6074, was a featured heifer calf in our 2006 sale to Rockin' B Land & Cattle in Missouri; and flush brothers record proven REA EPDs of +1.13 and +.88. Mademoiselle sells bred back to SydGen Survivor 7651, and two flush sisters will also be offered.
