Selling 90 Fall Yearling Bulls and 70 Spring Bull calves

Pictured is an example of the performance and phenotype we offer. He posted an adj. YW of 1,435 lbs. to ratio 110, scanned an 18 inch REA, and became the second high-selling fall yearling in last year's sale at \$14,000 to Kris Graupman, Palmyra, MO. He was on display at the 2018 National Western, then did light service at Graupman's in January and February. After breeding cows this spring, we brought him back to the farm in June and he was named Grand Champion Bull at the Missouri State Fair in August. Expect to see a deep offering of herd bull prospects again this year, with superior performance and phenotype, that excel on fescue! This sale has annually produced some of the leading AI sires of the breed, as well as numerous bulls performing in the pastures of purebred and commercial cattlemen across the U.S. All performance data is printed, including sale day frame and weights. Most will sell with genomically-enhanced EPDs.

Selling 60 Fall Pairs and 60 Spring Bred Cows and Heifers

This pair will be one of the highlights of the spring pairs. She's a daughter of SydGen Straight Up 8998 with \$28,000 in progeny sales on three calves, including **SYDGEN DESTINY 5393**, the second high-selling fall yearling bull in our 2016 offering. Her progeny record is 4 BWR-102, 4 WWR-103, 4 YWR-102, 4 IMF-116 and 4 REA-116. Her mid-February daughter of **SYDGEN EXCEED 3223**, pictured with her, also sells. SydGen Blackbird 1084 sells re-bred to **SYDGEN ENHANCE** to calve in February, 2019. Calves at-side will be weaned in September, and ready to go. The bred females and pairs will include several of this quality.
