We are excited to offer this yearling bull that has been used in our program, and has the potential to become an important sire in our line-up. He is the Number 2 YW son of Baldrige Colonel C251 in the breed, yet with +7 CED. He posted incredible performance data here, with ADG and YW ratios of 124 on a high forage ration, is exceptionally clean in his shoulder and stands on an exceptional set of feet and legs. His dam is the \$54,000-valuation Fortress daughter pictured below, co-owned with Knoll Crest Farm, Red House, VA. Her January 2019 natural calf by Epic, SydGen KCF Fail-Safe, will be one of the featured bull calves in the offering. Gavel was used here naturally this spring and bred heifers will sell carrying his service.

As one of the 30 head of spring-calving cows to sell, 2186 is the grandam of the \$25,000 top-selling bull in our 2018 event, SydGen Brickyard, now in service for Mogck & Sons, Olivet, SD. This high-performing daughter of the bull known as "Whiskey" will sell with a powerful January daughter at-side by SydGen Faith 6023, currently at +349 for \$Combination. She sells open and ready to flush, with some embryos available as well. A Pathfinder® flush sister to 2186 will also be offered, safe in calf to BCA Jeremiah 5103 (+307 \$C) and with a February heifer calf by Connealy Cool 39L, the breed's Number 1 Main Sire for \$Maternal.
